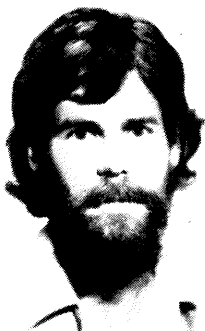

## From The Editor's Desk:

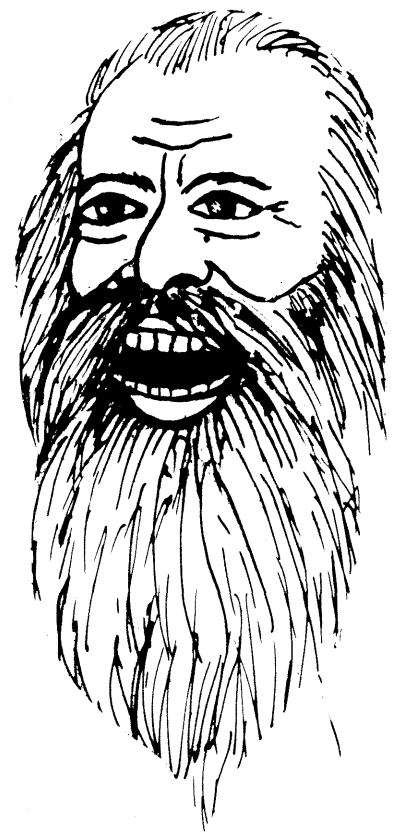

FINANCIAL REPORT

"Understanding Language"

The purpose of Language, as with any true Yoga, is the achievement of greater and higher expression of the Self. Please keep this change in relationship between the Scott Street household and the Foundation of Revelation in mind when making future contributions.

PAST AND FUTURE HISTORY - AND THE PERILS OF NUCLEAR POWER

Can you imagine how a Pharaoh of Egypt felt on a contemplative afternoon? Did he think his sacred beliefs would one day be the subject of horror movies? Did he imagine his tomb, so carefully prepared, would be opened, photographed - his very remains sent round the world to be seen in a land he never imagined existing? Anwar Sadat ruling his country? The Hebrew slaves, laboring at his bidding, spawning a civilization vaster than his own? Time has past and things have changed.

Today we are entombing Plutonium, refuse of the "breeder reactor". It must be maintained for thousands of years (virtually in perpetuity, but mankind has no experience with perpetual creations). The containers used to store it cannot last one hundred years. The United States is 200 years old - who do we think we are kidding? Do we know the civilization that will be here in 2100 A.D?

Preceding civilizations left us works of art. Are we to leave those that follow our deadly poisons? We know what radioactive substances can do. The people who produce them cannot take care of them - they just won't live that long. What right have they to force generations yet unborn to care for their garbage? No energy, no industry is worth that price. We have lived this long without atomic energy - who claims we can't live without it?

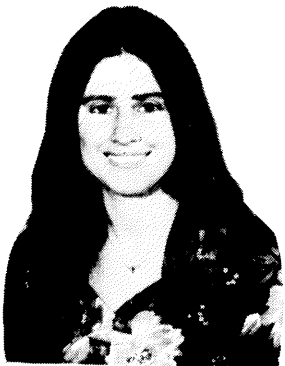
Those who produce radioactivity don't personally take care of it. They bribe others to do it with jobs and money. They go on producing more deadly poisons under a carefully constructed cloud of ignorance of the inevitable effects. Have they forgotten what they told us? Radioactivity can penetrate the cells of any living organism. If the dose is large, the cell is destroyed; if small, a disturbance is caused within the cell, altering the chemical code of reproduction, resulting in abnormal growth of existing tissue. Irradiated sex cells produce abnormal offspring, with strange and usually undesirable results. Could a sane or loving individual expose himself or others to radioactivity, at any price? If we consider the future, we can see that untold human suffering will be the price paid for poisons already released from testing and production of nuclear weapons and power plants. We have already crossed the line of safety. The sooner we stop disturbing the very basis of life, the cell, the longer we can exist - not merely as a civilization, but as a species.

President Carter has obviously contemplated these facts, and has temporarily halted production of the neutron bomb. He has moved against the breeder reactor. Governor Brown of California is looking for power sources other than nuclear. The California Energy Commission has halted the Sun Desert Project. Nuclear radiation is much more harmful than saccharine, nicotine, or marijuana. The industrialists who promote nuclear proliferation are more interested in money, than in the health or safety of the people of America, or of the world. Governments who continue nuclear testing are merely inflating their national egos, not protecting the lives of the people of this planet.

More money was spent to defeat Proposition 15, the California Initiative for Nuclear Safety, than was ever spent on any initiative in the history of the State. It was spent by those who plan to benefit financially from booms in reactor building and sales of nuclear-created electricity. They count their profits while cells mutate and abnormal reproduction takes place in all forms of life. It's time we woke up, and put an end to all forms of destructive folly. The splitting of the atom, from which ensues the destruction of the cell - the basis of life itself - is the most sinister and least understood form of destructive activity engaged in today.

If we can now plan the future, using the scientific knowledge of which we are so proud, we have a chance to undo our past mistakes. Remember and understand. Preserve life. Give up greed. Throughout time, God has spoken to us through various divinely-inspired individuals, imploring us to love one another, not hurt and lie to each other. Let us give up hostility, preserve "Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness", and be remembered as a great Truth-Conscious civilization, the first to save itself from self-destruction and LIVE to tell the tale.

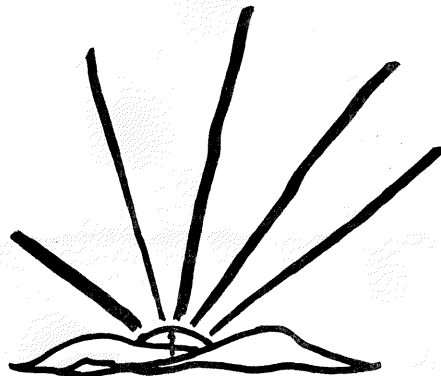

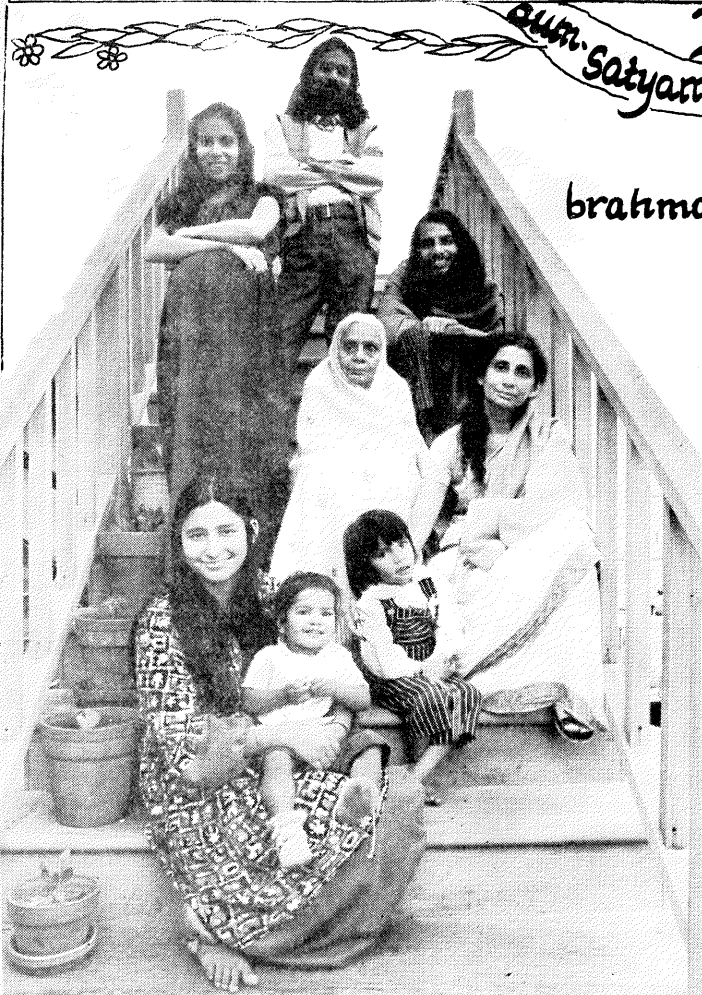
